


ADAPTATION PROCESSES



Compensation Hypothesis & Cognitive Behavioral Therapy




"The child is thought of as an active 'cognitive constructor' of his/her social world."

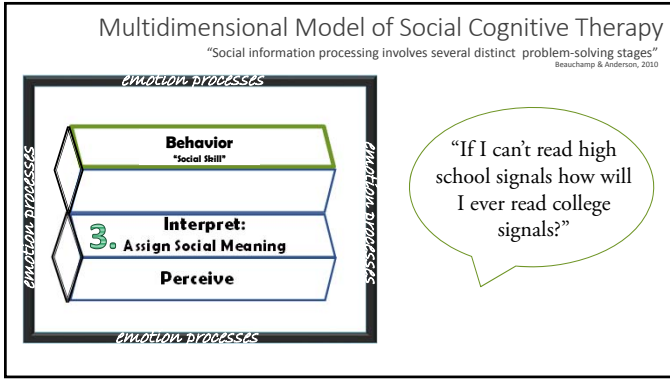

Social Information Filter

1. Intervention Checklist: DOES THE INTERVENTION...
...provide a framework for attending to nonverbal cues of others?
...allow for practice in identifying the nonverbal cues of others?
...provide framework to help client process their own social 'signals'?
...solicit examples of conveying social information to others?
...include metacognitive strategies to enhance overall attention?

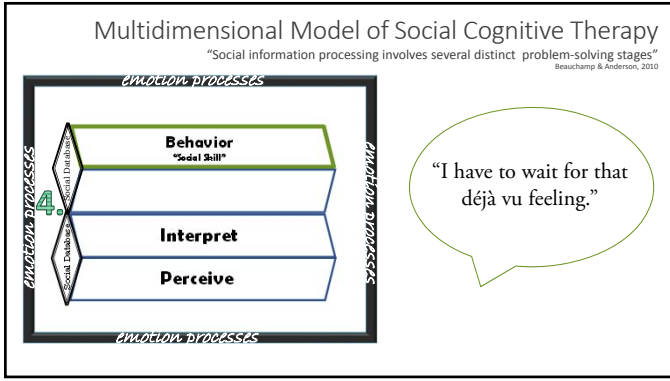
Social Cognitive Therapy
Assigning Social Meaning

3. Intervention Checklist: DOES THE INTERVENTION...
...explicit teaching related to TOM or taking the perspective of another?
...explicitly teach strategies to infer the perspective of others?
...increase cognitive awareness of nonliteral speech, metaphorical expression, sarcasm and humor?
...provide a framework for interpreting social overtures of others including differentiating between friendship, and less formal interactions?
...explain and challenge patterns of misreading social cues and intent?

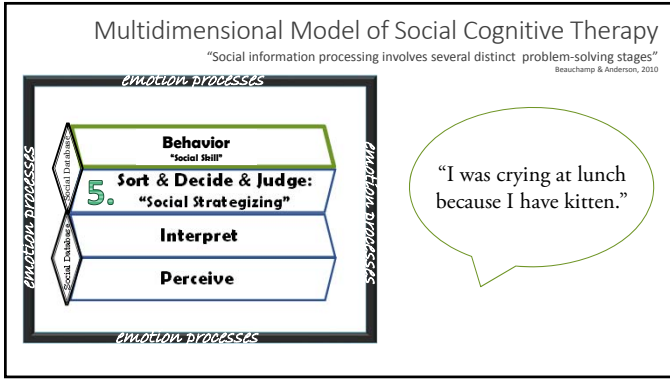

5. Intervention Checklist: DOES THE INTERVENTION...
...introduce, explore and provide a framework for metacognitive strategies?
...provide instruction and practice for self-talk strategies?
...provide a way for self-monitoring and self-reinforcement?
...teach strategies for assertiveness, and self-advocacy?
...provide guided practice with peers and less familiar social situations?
